Triacta receives OPA Conservation Award

This award recognizes Triacta, the Rainbow District School Board and the Dearness Conservation Program for energy efficiency efforts at the Valley View Public School in Sudbury, Ontario.

Mr. Love, along with Jennifer Hassani of Triacta, Tom Tamblyn of the Dearness Conservation, and Anthony Da Silva of Ameresco Canada were joined by Rainbow school board officials where they toured the school facilities.

Triacta's electricity monitoring system is an integral step to helping the school board identify and monitor its electricity use. "In all effective energy plans, monitoring is key to achieving and maximizing energy renewal", said Rainbow Board Chair Dena Morrison. "For this reason, Rainbow District School Board has been installing Triacta smart meters in its schools. The meters monitor electricity use so further savings can be achieved. The Board's efforts have resulted in overall energy cost savings of \$341,000 during the 2005-2006 school year.
